<u>INSTRUCTIONS FOR FORM 2.604 – NOTICE OF PENDING MATTER</u>

This form is to be filed and served on the Judge if you have not received an Order from the Court for 60 days or more after your hearing or request for judicial action.

- 1. Complete the Caption: The Plaintiff is the person[s] or entity that brought the lawsuit. The Defendant is the person[s] or entities being sued. The case number is the number that was assigned by the Clerk of Court when the case was filed.
- 2. Complete the body of the Notice: The first blank should be the name of the person or entity asking the Court to take action. The second blank is the name or the motion that you are waiting for the Court to take action on. The third blank is the date that your Motion was filed and the fourth blank is the document number for the Motion that was filed, if available.
- 3. Complete the Certificate of Service: The first blank is the date you are filing the notice. The Second blank is for the names and eservice email address of all parties to the case. Next, check the box for the method of delivery to the parties.
- 4. Complete the signature block and make sure that you sign the Notice. An electronic signature is acceptable.
- 5. Once you have filed the Notice with the Clerk of Court, you must submit a copy to the Judge as instructed in the Judge's divisional instructions which can be found on their website.
